#INSPIRING PEOPLE

#WE Ignite

Dr. S. Radhakrishnan : A Philosopher and Teacher Par Excellence

Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan was first Vice President of India and second President of India. He was also a philosopher and introduced the thinking of western idealist philosophers into Indian thought.

Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan was born on September 5, 1888 at Tiruttani, Madras in a poor Brahmin family. As his father was poor Radhakrishnan supported most of his education through scholarships. After completing his M.A., Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, accepted an Assistant Lectureship at the Madras Presidency College in 1909. In college, he mastered the classics of Hindu philosophy, namely the Upanishads, Bhagavad Gita, Brahma Sutras, and commentaries of Sankara, Ramanuja and Madhva. He also acquainted himself with Buddhist and Jain philosophy and philosophies of Western thinkers such as Plato, Plotinus, Kant, Bradley, and Bergson.

Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan was called to Oxford University, to deliver lectures on Hindu philosophy. He used his lectures as a platform to further India's cause for freedom. He also argued that Western philosophers, despite all claims to objectivity, were biased by theological influences from their wider culture. He showed that Indian philosophy, once translated into standard academic jargon, is worthy of being called philosophy by Western standards. He thus placed Indian Philosophy on world map.

In 1931, Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan was elected Vice Chancellor of the Andhra University. In 1939, Radhakrishnan became the Vice Chancellor of the Banaras Hindu University. In 1946, he was appointed as Ambassador to UNESCO. After Independence Dr. Radhakrishnan was requested to Chair the University Education Commission in 1948. The Radhakrishnan Committee's suggestions helped mould the education system for India's needs. In 1949, Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan was appointed ambassador to the Soviet Union. He helped laid the foundation for a strong relationship with Soviet Union. Radhakrishnan was elected first Vice-President of India in 1952. He was honored with the Bharat Ratna in 1954. After serving two terms as Vice-President, Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan was elected President of India in 1962. He retired as President in 1967 and settled in Madras. When he became the President of India, some of his students and friends requested him to allow them to celebrate his birthday, on 5 September. He replied, "Instead of celebrating my birthday, it would be my proud privilege if September 5th is observed as Teachers' Day." His birthday has since been celebrated as Teacher's' Day in India. !!!!!!!Happy teachers day to all Pydah Staff!!

Ice Hotel - Sweden

The Icehotel is a hotel rebuilt each year with snow and ice in the village of Jukkasjarvi, in northern Sweden, about 17 kilometres (11 mi) from Kiruna. It is the world's first ice hotel. The hotel, including the chairs and beds, is constructed from snow and ice blocks taken from the nearby Torne River. Artists are invited to create different rooms and decorations made by ice. Besides bedrooms, there is a bar, with glasses made of ice and an ice chapel that is popular with marrying couples.

Ice hotels are dependent on sub-freezing temperatures. The structure remains below freezing, around -5°C (23°F). Ice hotels are promoted for adventurous travelers who are interested in novelties and unusual environments and are comfortable with the outdoors. Customers have to be prepared to sleep in beds made of snow or ice, but in the warmth of furs, blankets and sleeping bags designed to withstand extremely cold temperatures. Temperature in the rooms is below zero Celsius, but much warmer than outside. The Icehotel only exists between December and April, and has been listed as one of the Seven Wonders of Sweden. The northern hemisphere's aurora borealis can be seen during the winter month in the location. Staying at an ice hotel is expensive as prices for a night range from around US \$300 to \$3,000.

#BOON OF TECHNOLOGY

Greenhouse Technology

Agriculture is the backbone of India's economic activity and Growing plants is both an art and a science. About 95% of plants, either food crops or cash crops are grown in open field. Since time immemorial, man has learnt how to grow plants under natural environmental conditions. In some of the temperate regions where the climatic conditions are extremely adverse and no crops can be grown, man has developed methods of growing some high value crop continuously by providing protection from the excessive cold, which is called as Greenhouse Technology. So, Greenhouse Technology is the technique of providing favourable environment condition to the plants. It is rather used to protect the plants from the adverse climatic conditions such as wind, cold, precipitation, excessive radiation, extreme temperature, insects and diseases. It is also of vital importance to create an ideal micro climate around the plants. This is possible by erecting a greenhouse / glass house, where the environmental conditions are so modified that one can grow any plant in any place at any time by providing suitable environmental conditions with minimum labour.



Advantages of greenhouses:

1. The yield may be 10-12 times higher than that of outdoor cultivation depending upon the type of greenhouse, type of crop, environmental control facilities.
2. Ideally suited for vegetables and flower crops.
3. Year round production of floricultural crops.
4. Off-season production of vegetable and fruit crops.
5. Disease-free and genetically superior transplants can be produced continuously.
6. Modern techniques of Hydroponic (Soil less culture), Aeroponics and Nutrient film techniques are possible only under greenhouse cultivation.

Conclusions :

Site selection is crucial for profitable and sustainable greenhouse production. The climate influences the type and level of greenhouse technology (structure and internal equipment for climate control) and subsequent crop production conditions, which in turn influence product cost and quality. The distance to markets, especially in export-focused production, can be a limiting factor for profitable greenhouse cultivation. An economic compromise between the investment costs of the greenhouses and equipment and their agricultural performance is necessary to produce proper quality commodities at a competitive level.
